First day of meeting started with welcome speech by Mrs. Renata Ochoa-Daderska, President of Fundacja Instytut Badan I Innowacji W Edukacji, our hosting partner.

Mrs. Medine Güney, project coordinator, presented the current status of our project, with a refresh on the objectives and the roles of each partner. All partners informed about the updates regarding project implementation status in their own countries as well as reports on the local training events.

#### **Target groups:**

- Direct participants – 15 language teachers/teacher trainers from the partner organisations
- Indirect participants – 90 language teachers, working with adults (adults - over 20 years olds)
- Beneficiaries – 600 adults who are learning a second language

Training events were organized in each of the partner countries, following the LTTA organized in Milan, Italy with the expertise of our partner Europe for All and after the completion of the guidebook „*Guide for the application of the Montessori method to teaching 2nd language in adult education*”.

- Romania – May 2021, 22 participants
- Poland – May 2021, 16 participants
- Turkey – June 2021, 16 participants
- Austria -
- Portugal – June 2021, 14 participants
- Italy – to be completed

Mr. Luis Ochoa Siguencia explained the procedure for reporting the local events, with examples of the Polish team already completed.

- 1 infographic report containing photos and short descriptions, for each of the major events dedicated to the dissemination and multiplication of project results (such as organized conferences, local LTTA, etc.)

- 1 written report for each of the major events dedicated to the dissemination and multiplication of project results (such as organized conferences, local LTTA, etc.), containing the following sections: organizer, profile of the participants, visibility, agenda, short feedback on the event
- 1 written report for all the other smaller scale events in which the project was shared locally.

**Deadline** for the upload of the reports on the project [Dropbox](#) is 15 October.

The preparation of the guideline of LTTA event report format was discussed among partners. This report is to be included in the final version of the „*Guide for the application of the Montessori method to teaching 2nd language in adult education*” and will consist of 3-6 pages of detailed report on the implementation of the local LTTA events, with 3 main subtitles: INTRO, METHODOLOGY and FEEDBACK (from the participants and from their learners).

**Deadline** for the upload of the first version of this chapter of the guidebook in the project [Dropbox](#) is 1<sup>st</sup> of November.





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Second day of the transnational project meeting started with a sum up of the previous day and with Mrs. Medine Guney, presenting the tasks of the partners until the next transnational project meeting, including the need to create rollups and banners in all partner organizations. Project activities, joint tasks and individual partner task distribution were all reiterated and the next tasks were underlined.

The meeting went on with a discussion on the dissemination strategy, led by Mr. Luis Ochoa Siguencia. The impact of the published guidebook is significant, already reaching the indicators targeted in the application form. Mrs. Anabela Mateus presented the social media impact report prepared by her colleague at Cofac Cooperativa De Formacao Animacao Cultural CRL, Portugal, Ms. Carolina Godinho, sharing stats and concluding the need to intensify posts, with contribution from all partners.

We had the opportunity to discuss about our initiatives on the occasion of Erasmus Days 2021 and partners presented their plans for dissemination for the following months.

We discussed and agreed upon the next face to face meetings of the project management team.

- Romania, 2-3 December 2021
- Portugal, 3-4 February 2022
- Austria, 10-11 March 2022

Dates for other activities carried out transnationally and work plans will be firmly established at the next meeting or as needed via online communication channels. All partners have committed to ensuring a safe implementation of the remaining of the activities, taking into consideration covid-19 related local and international restrictions.

Partners also agreed to a project activities update meeting, held online, at the end of October 2021.

Ms. Magdalena Miladinovic presented a research led by VAEV, Austria, with the subject being the influence of COVID19 pandemic on the activities of organizations implementing youth and volunteering projects.

The project partners also discussed about possible follow-up actions as result of the current project and a new proposal to build up on the finding and results of the MMTLA project was taken into consideration.





Meeting evaluation was done informally by direct feedback at the end of second day of TPM and via Google Forms, sent by the project coordinator to all attendees.

All participants received certificates as an evidence of attendance and participation at the transnational project meeting.





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
